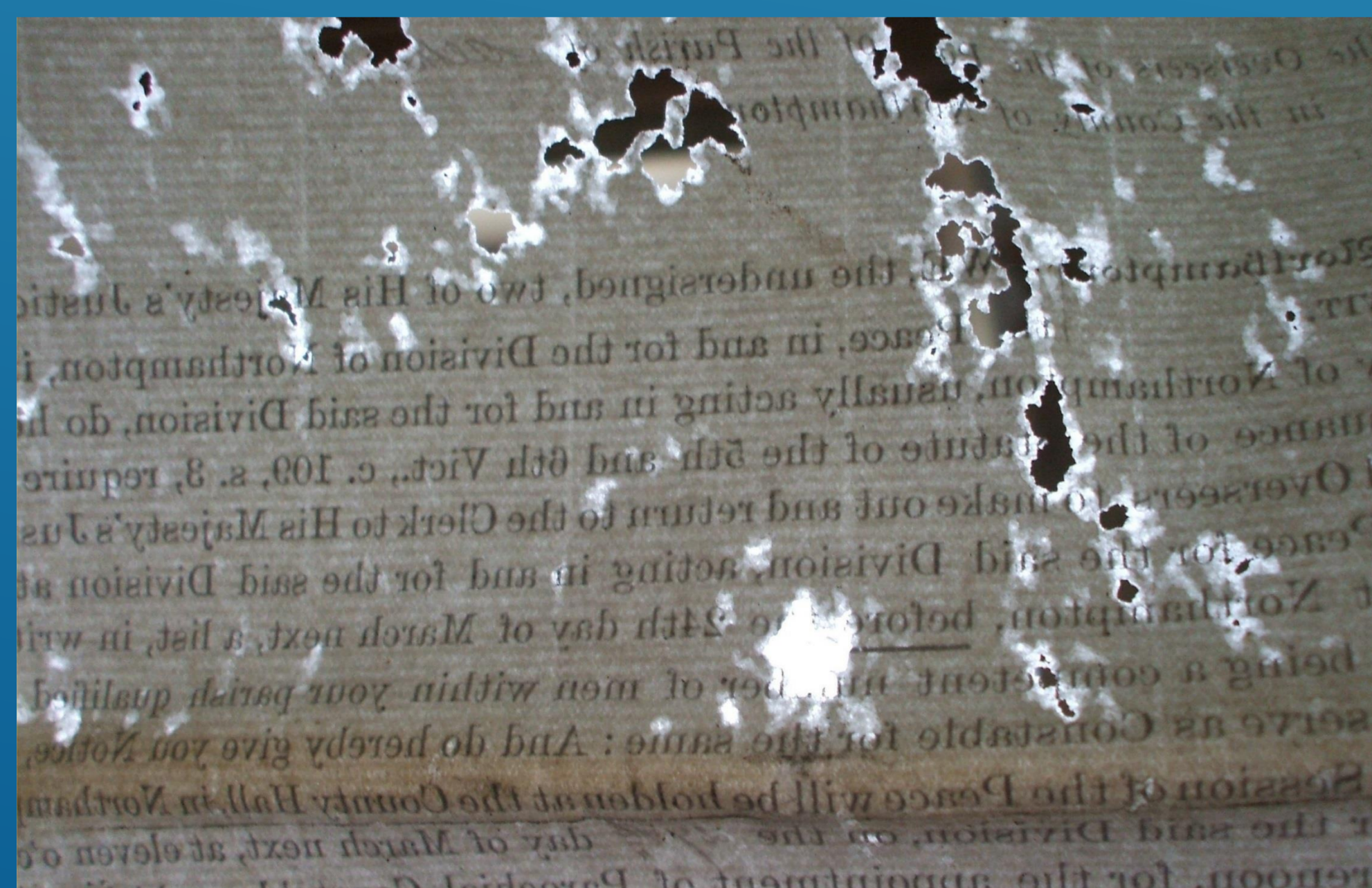
## Who are we?
